THE SCHOOL

Founded in 1970, Fayetteville Academy is an independent, co-educational, college preparatory day school for students in pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade. Fayetteville is located 63 miles south of Raleigh and is North Carolina's sixth largest municipality. It is home to Fort Bragg, the nation's largest Army installation.

Fayetteville Academy is accredited by the Southern Association of Independent Schools (SAIS) and Cognia and is a member of the following organizations: National, Southern, and North Carolina Associations of Independent Schools, National Association for College Admission Counseling, Southern Association for College Admission Counseling, North Carolina Independent Schools Athletic Association, and the Military Child Coalition.

ENROLLMENT

Enrollment: August 2022: 393 (PreK-12), 107 (9-12); 25% of our students are military dependents and 43% are minorities. Approximately 38% of our students receive financial aid.

Staff: Approximately 72% of the administrators and faculty associated with the Upper School have earned advanced degrees.

COVID-19 INFORMATION

Due to COVID-19, instruction from March 16, 2020 through June 4, 2020 was completed remotely through multiple online platforms determined by Fayetteville Academy. Grading remained the same, but final exams were not given. Instruction for the 2020-2021 school year was in person with a hybrid option available for students and families who requested it. Instruction for the 2021-22 school year was in person with a hybrid option reserved for students in quarantine.
