

2023-2024 Fayetteville Academy Admissions Referral Program

Eligibility

- Current or former families, alumni, or the community at large can be granted referral awards for the referral of new students enrolling for the 2023-24 year in grades 1-12 only.
- No referral credit(s) will be given for an enrolling student who has previously been enrolled at Fayetteville Academy or who has a sibling who is currently or has previously been enrolled at Fayetteville Academy.
- For families enrolling multiple students during their initial enrollment at Fayetteville Academy ("F.A."), a referral can be awarded for each student enrolling at that time.

Process

- Parent(s) or guardian(s) of newly applying student will sign an official form provided by F.A. naming one currently enrolled person (family) as the one who directly referred them to F.A.
- All newly inquiring and applying families will be asked by the Director of Admission if they were referred to F.A. by any one in the above noted group.
- The form must be filled in and signed prior to or during the application process. The deadline for submission of referral forms will be at the time that the application is submitted.

Referral Reward

- For each referred student who enrolls, the referring person (family) will receive a credit to reduce the cost of their oldest enrolled child's tuition for the following year only/or the referring person (family) will receive a check in the amount commensurate with the terms noted below..
- The credit will be in the amount of 5% of the new enrolling student's full grade-level tuition rounded up to the nearest dollar.
- There is no limit to the number of referral credits that a family may receive except the total may not exceed 100% of the tuition due.
- The credit will be shown as a credit to the student account through the F.A. billing system or, if not an F.A. family, it will be distributed as a check.
- The referral credit will be earned for one year only and will be credited in full during the first year of enrollment of the new student (second semester).
- The referral credit is non-transferable and can only be credited to the referring family's or individual's account.
- The referral credit can be declined by the referring individual or family if written notice is given to the Director of Finance and/or the Head of School.
- Referral Awards can only be assigned to one currently enrolled or appropriately designated family and will not be spread over multiple accounts. Referral awards will be issued after the start of the second semester of the active school year in session.

Disclaimer

- Given that circumstances can vary for each particular enrollment situation, final determination of any referral to be paid will be at the sole discretion of the Head of School.
